Key Updates to the Michigan Pupil Accounting Manual: 2025-2026

This guide highlights the most notable changes in the 2025-2026 Pupil Accounting Manual regarding **documentation**, **attendance tracking**, and **rules for special pupil populations** to ensure compliance and accurate reporting for Michigan school districts.

DOCUMENTATION & REPORTING CHANGES

Stricter Teacher Placement Rules

Teachers must now be appropriately placed for both grade level and subject area.

No More 'Placeholder' Courses

Schedules must list actual course names before count day, with few exceptions.

Clarified Nonconventional Pupil Identification
Districts must identify and document pupils in all applicable nonconventional program categories.

ATTENDANCE & SCHEDULING UPDATES

Mandatory Certified Attendance Records

To be official, attendance records must be reviewed and signed by the teacher of record.

Plan Ahead for Virtual Days

District calendars must now account for foreseeable virtual instruction days allowed under Section 21f.

New Guidance for Co-Taught Classes

Clarified rules for calculating membership for special education pupils in co-taught classrooms.

SPECIAL PUPIL POPULATION RULES

Tuition Prohibited for Most Nonresidents

Beginning with the February 2026 count, districts cannot charge tuition for nonresident pupils.

Revamped Birth-to-Five SE Section

Section 5-K was renamed and membership requirements were clarified for each program type.

New Considerations for Home-Based Placements

Added specific guidance for placing students with disabilities in home-based educational settings.

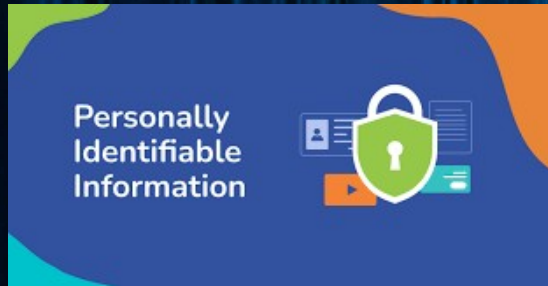

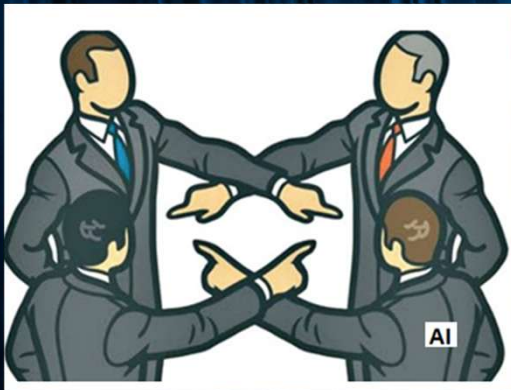

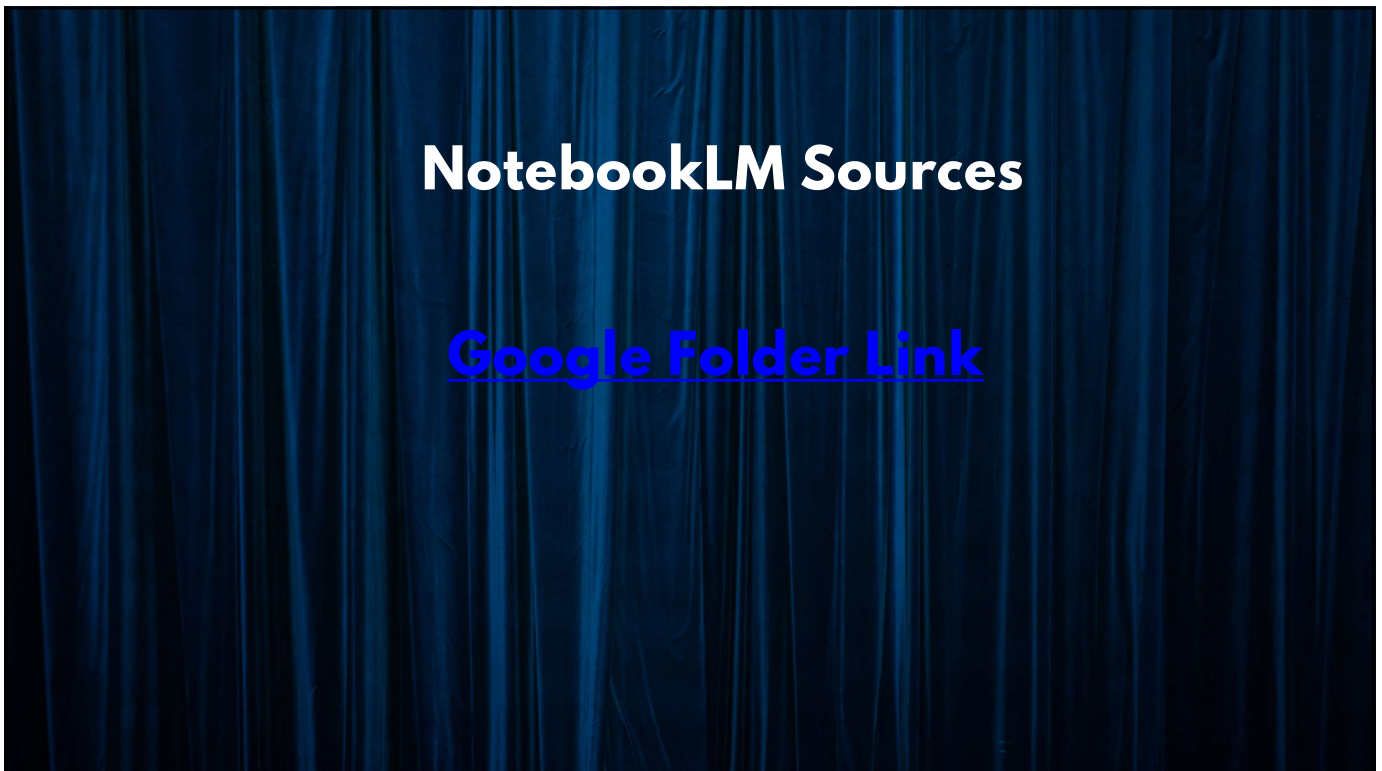
