Position Summary: The Project Director will be responsible for the implementation of the MiEWIMS Statewide Project.

- Understanding of the role of ISDs and their relationship with local school districts

- Work closely with the Application Development Director, Instructional Applications to cross-support and promote MAISAs instructional resources and online tools.
- Support the ongoing effort in MiKidsBackOnTrack.
- Co-facilitate the statewide actionable data advisory.
