For over one hundred years, the Northern Michigan Asylum, later named the Traverse City State Hospital, served over 50,000 patients on a campus of over fifty buildings on more than 1000 acres.

The story of the Northern Michigan Asylum and The Village redevelopment is central to the history of Traverse City. Our guided tours offer enriching perspectives on the many facets of one of Michigan's most important historic sites. From Dr. Munson's "Beauty is Therapy" theory on patient care, to the former uses of the structures on the property, our tours are intended to both enlighten and entertain. All tours include a walk through the amazing 1885 brick steam tunnels.
